**From Drug Smuggling Hoodlum to Assistant  
Director of our Men's Home**



This month we would like to showcase our Assistant Director Aaron Makin. His testimony is a wonderful story of redemption. Truly he is a miracle, a "treasure out of Darkness". Aaron came to our ministry in 2003; his background was drug dealing, drug smuggling, and a life of addiction. Jesus delivered him and used our

ministry to transform Aaron; he graduated from our One Year Program successfully. Here are his own words,

"God set me free from tremendous amount of demonic oppression. He used the Ministry to work out and heal many different character problems that plagued my life. My friend was killed in a drug war, and my own life was in grave danger as well due to the violent evils connected to drug dealing. I was hunted like an animal. In the midst of this drug war, I gave my life to Jesus Christ, and entered the Hope For Homeless Youth Discipleship program. I went thru much discipleship and healing during my time at the Program. Jesus took a lot of pride out of my heart, and used the discipleship to change me. I started to really fall in Love with Jesus. After graduating from the program, I went to Bible College and was ordained. After that I began serving in the Healing Room Ministry in Spokane, Washington. After some years, I have now returned to Hope For Homeless Youth and for many months have served as Assistant Director at the Men's Home at 91<sup>st</sup> Street. "
